
This section is used to wrap up the grammar point through a grammar chant. Grammar chants use simple but effective repetition to help learners speak English automatically.



- Introduce the grammar point, regular plurals using the Teacher Tool Slides. We add '-s' at the end of the noun for the plural form. If the nouns end in '-f' or '-fe,' change 'f' into 'v' and add '-es.' If the nouns end in '-y,' change 'y' into 'i' and add '-es.'
- Help student practice changing singular nouns into plural nouns using the Teacher Tool Slides.





C Mark O or X.

- Have students name and count each picture in the Student Book.
- Help students practice changing singular nouns into plural nouns correctly using the Teacher Tool Slides.
- Have students turn to the Student Book and complete Section C by themselves. While students are working, walk around the classroom to make sure that every student is working correctly.



D Look and circle.

- Have students name and count each picture in the Student Book.







 The plural form of 'sheep,' 'fish,' and 'deer' is just 'sheep,' 'fish,' and 'deer.'
