Simple and clear conversations provide communicational expressions, using the grammar learned from Grammar Point.




# **Grammar Practice**

Some countable nouns have irregular plural forms, such as 'men' or 'children.' Also, there are some nouns that take plural forms but have singular meanings such as 'glasses.' These nouns are usually considered as a pair.
