
Student Book



Unit Introduction presents the unit title and the type of writing that will be introduced in the Model Writing section. Various types of writing, such as essays, diary entries, letters, emails, reports, etc., are introduced in the units.


How About You? presents questions that help students brainstorm about the unit topic. The students can prepare for the unit by practicing in advance the expressions that they will learn.

Words & Pictures activities feature the main key words of the unit. Students learn these words by listening and participating in various activities, such as finding the words in the pictures, using stickers, matching the words and pictures, and talking about the pictures using the key words.



WORDS introduces a set of topic-based vocabulary through activities that allow students to listen to, read, and write the words.

SENTENCES 1-3 introduce target sentence structures by presenting different activities that allow students to apply the key words from the previous section to the new structures and to practice writing the new structures as full sentences.



IDEA MAPPING presents a visual map for Model Writing that helps students learn how to brainstorm their ideas. It logically and visually arranges the words and structures students previously learned.

MODEL WRITING features the model writing passage of the unit. The students are asked to fill out the blanks in the passage using the expressions and sentences from Idea Mapping.




MY IDEA MAP presents a blank idea map form for students to fill in with their own ideas. They are encouraged to use the structures they learned from the Idea Mapping activity and are introduced to expressions they can use with those structures. Students can refer to this page when they complete My Writing.

MY WRITING presents a section that allows students to write their own piece of writing. Students can utilize the expressions, sentence structures, and the Model Writing from previous sections in the unit to complete their writing.




Review Unit reviews the target sentence structures students learned in the previous four units. Students can learn new phrases through question-and-answer activities and completing an idea chart. These sections help students review and practice the structures so that they can complete a new writing passage.

Extra Materials





Portfolio Book features blank sheets at the back of the Student Book for students to rewrite the final copy of their writing activity.




