Introduction

Phonics Race is a new student and teacher-friendly phonics series developed for preprimary and primary students learning English as a foreign language. Phonics Race is a
4-level phonics program mainly focused on phonemic awareness and phonics, yet it also
implements spelling and reading fluency to help students become confident readers. The
units are presented in an easy-to-follow sequence from sound to letter and word to story.
In addition, it is designed in an entertaining way with 4 adorable characters: Red Ace,
Yellow Betty, Green Chase, and Blue Dickie, who appear in Phonics Race Readers, too.



SOUND RACE

In each unit, the target sounds are introduced with the hidden picture activity. Students learn to identify the sounds of spoken words and develop phonemic awareness through the hidden picture activity. After acquiring the target sound, the relationship between the target sound and the letter is introduced. This section is completed by listening and speaking the target sounds followed by a chant. Students learn and practice the sound-letter relationship.



LETTER RACE

Students practice identifying the target sounds and letters. They strengthen their sound-letter recognition skills. And their knowledge about the target sounds is expanded to the word level. Students can recognize the target sounds in many words.







Students can practice the words with the target sounds. They also consolidate their decoding skills for words.

In this section, students review the sounds and words learned in the previous 5 units.




Phonics Race Readers

Ten authentic stories are provided for the further reading practice. Students review the words with target sounds in the stories which are directly related to each unit.




