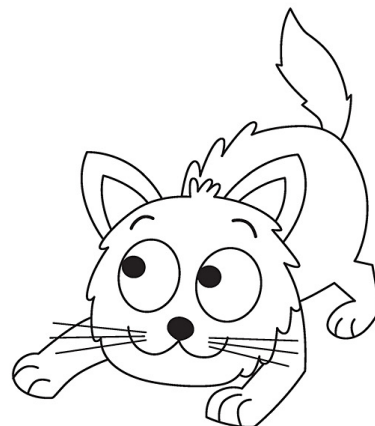

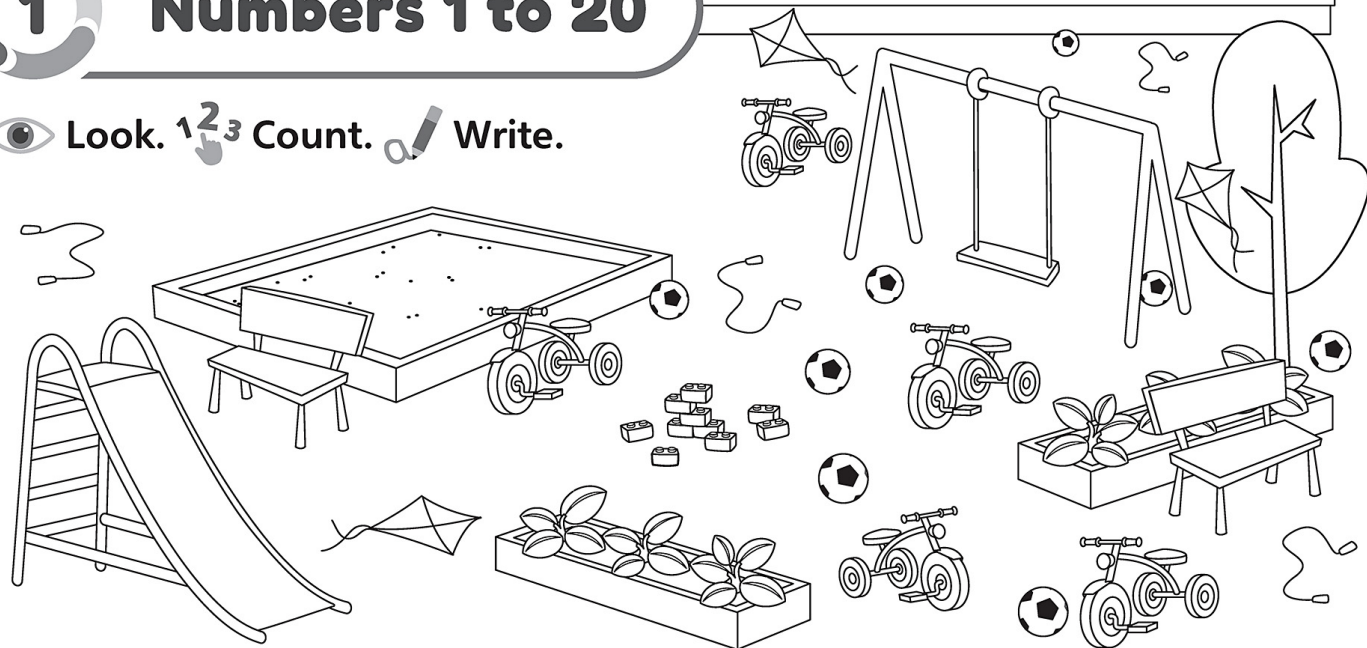
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## Numbers 1 to 20

Look. <sup>1</sup><sub>2</sub><sup>3</sup> Count. Write.














**Presentation:** Make a set of cards with one to ten objects found on a playground on each card (slide, kite, jump rope, tricycle, ball, blocks). Show children a card. Ask: *What's this? (A slide.) How many (slides) can you see?* Children count and say. They open their books, and find and count each object in the picture. Then, they write the correct numbers.

**Practice:** Give children a white sheet of paper and different-colored pencils. Put the cards with playground objects inside a bag. Play music. Children pass around the bag. Stop the music. The child with the bag pulls out a card, shows it to the class, and counts the pictures on it. Children write the correct number on their sheet of paper using the color you say.
