


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#### ON THE COVER

#### The Oldest Message in a Bottle in the World

Have you ever found anything interesting on a beach? In 2018, the Illman family found a bottle on the beach in Western Australia. When they picked it up, they saw a piece of paper inside it. They took the bottle and the piece of paper home and looked at it more carefully. There was a message in German on the piece of paper, but it was very difficult to read. However, the Illmans could read some words, including a name, Paula, and a date, June 12th, 1886.

The Illmans took the bottle and the message to the Western Australia Museum in Perth. Of course, the people at the museum wanted to find out some more **information**, so they **contacted** some museums in Germany. Now they know the whole story of the message in the bottle. It's from a German boat called

Paula, and it's been inside the bottle since 1886. It's been there for more than 130 years! The boat was on the Indian Ocean—950 kilometers from Western Australia—when the people on board threw the bottle into the ocean.

For the Illmans, finding the bottle—and learning that it was so old—was an incredible experience!


