### Walking With Giants

Hans Weise is a film director. He

Hans uses models instead. He works with a designer, Fernando Baptista, to make models of the people, places and objects. Fernando paints the models and then Hans takes photos of them. 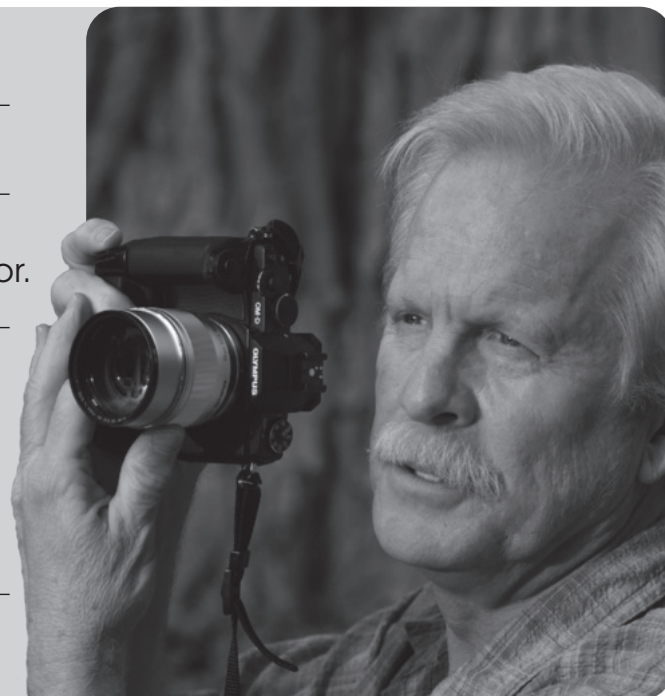
