- every day / every week / every Sunday
- usually
- always











Hi, I'm David.

I usually wake up at seven o'clock.

I have a friend.

Her name is Kelly.

She has breakfast at eight o'clock.

She swims every morning.

She has a brother.

His name is Andy.

He jogs in the park every evening.

He has a dog.

The dog jogs, too.




