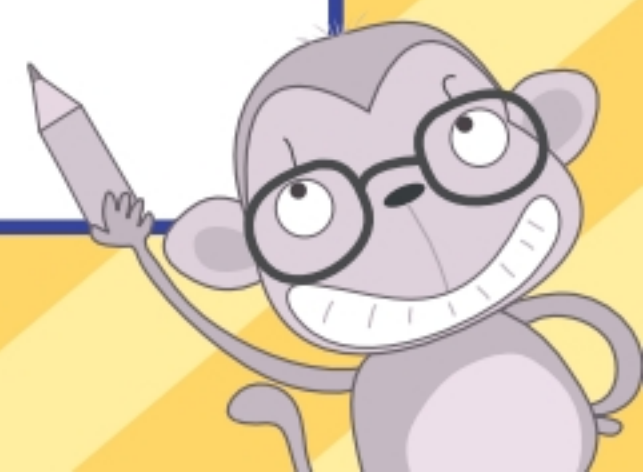

**Uncountable nouns** are those we can't count. We **can't** use a/an or numbers before them.

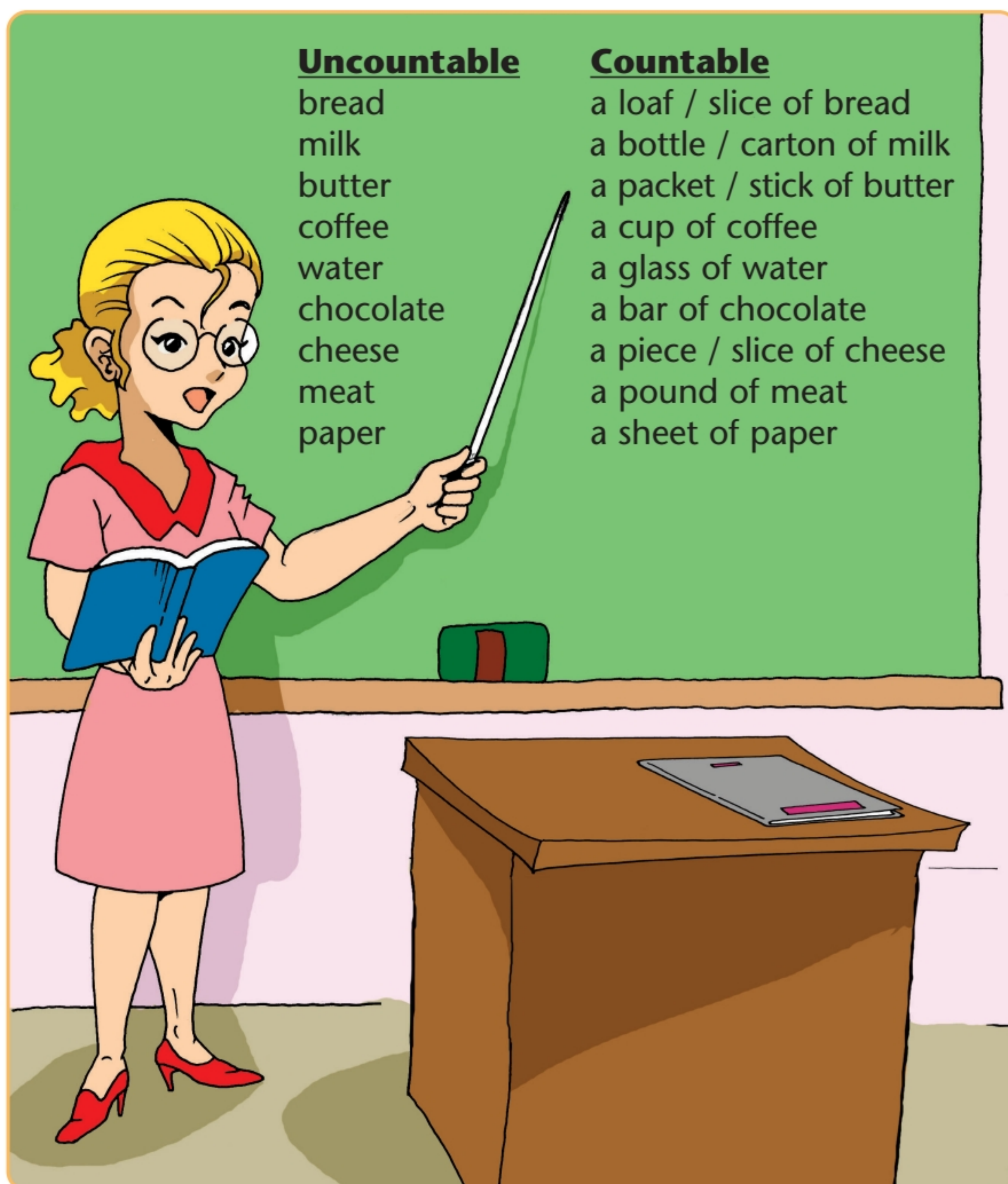
<b>a</b> banana / <b>six</b> bananas	I ate <b>a</b> banana. / He ate <b>six</b> bananas.

Liquids water / tea	They drink <b>water</b> . / She doesn't like <b>tea</b> .
Some Food Items bread / meat	He likes <b>bread</b> . / I ate <b>meat</b> for dinner.
Materials gold / wood	<b>Gold</b> is expensive. / She cuts <b>wood</b> .
