#### **READING A**


Students read a level-appropriate passage about a familiar and interesting topic using the Key Words.

This section checks students' understanding of the reading passage through the use of varied exercises. These exercises introduce students to basic reading comprehension and help form the foundation of a student's reading literacy.




#### **LITERACY UPGRADE**

#### **UOCABULARY CHECK**


This section provides an opportunity to review the Unit Words and practice spelling them through puzzles and matching activities.
