

AUDIO QR


A QR code at the beginning of each unit links to the audio tracks of the Key Words and Reading section.

Students read a level-appropriate passage about a familiar and interesting topic using the Key Words.


READING B

This section checks students' understanding of the reading passage through the use of varied exercises. These exercises introduce students to basic reading comprehension and help form the foundation of a student's reading literacy.




LITERACY UPGRADE

WORKBOOK


UOCABULARY CHECK
