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
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
How to Use This Book

Each unit in *Jungle Phonics* includes four parts plus additional review activities to guide young learners as they take the first step on their journey into English. In each unit, learners first focus on individual sounds and target words. Then, they gain familiarity with the sound by completing simple reading, writing, speaking, and listening activities. With this approach, learners can acquire English in an easy and interesting way. Various types of activities, chants and stories allow young learners to effectively acquire the basics of phonics and enable them to build confidence with English. Lots of common sight words are used in stories and chants to help learners build their sight word vocabulary naturally.

Students learn only one sound at a time before moving on to the next sound. With this step-by-step exposure to learning points, learners can acquire and remember each new sound and word more easily. Students can develop a better understanding of each sound and target word with simple and easy activities.



Students gain more exposure to the target sounds through various activities to consolidate their learning.

Students practice reading the target words and common sight words in context. Two activities provide listening practice, and students can read and chant along with the story.
