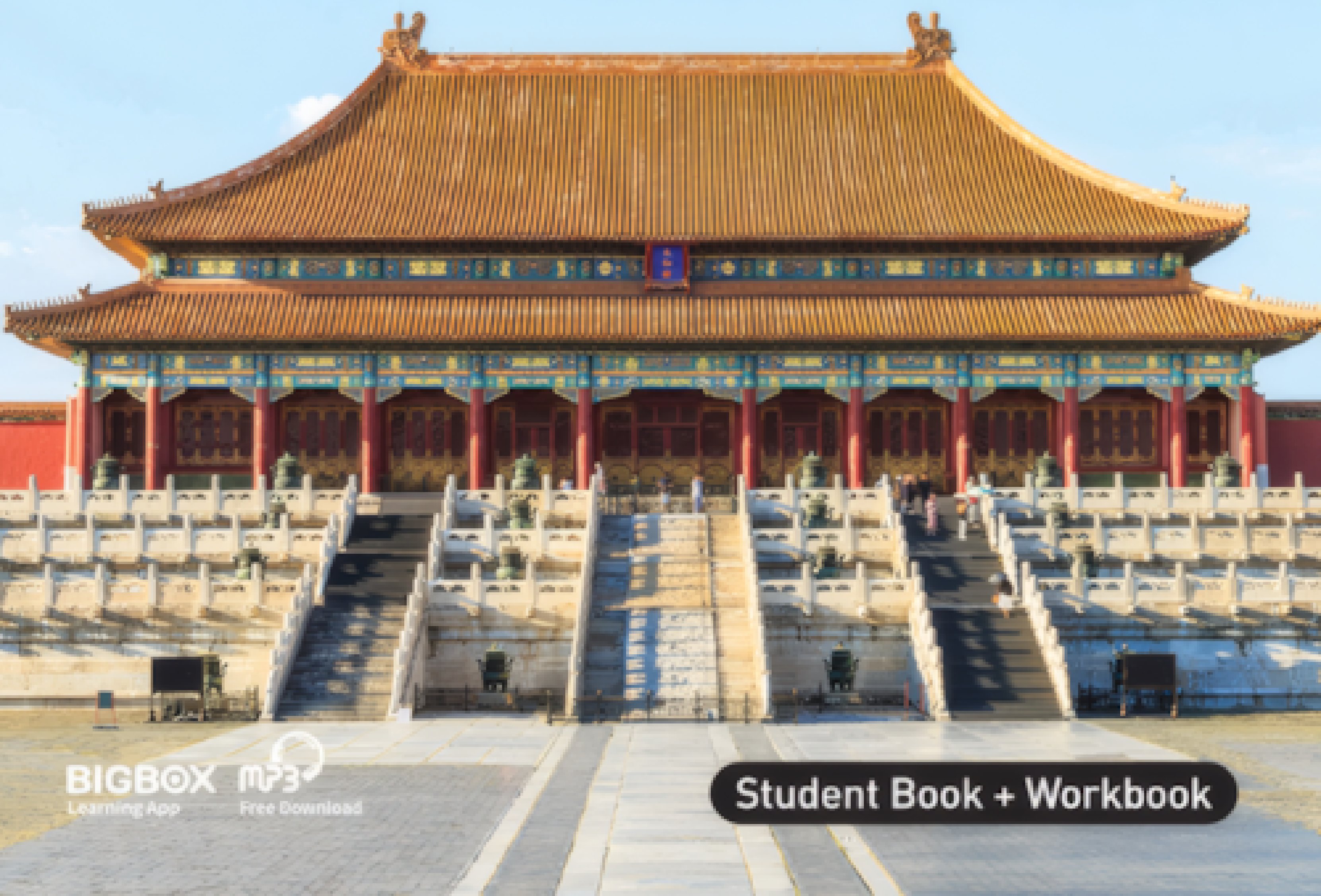

## See with Your Eyes!

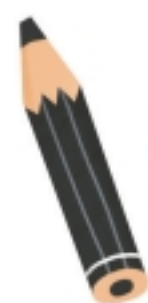

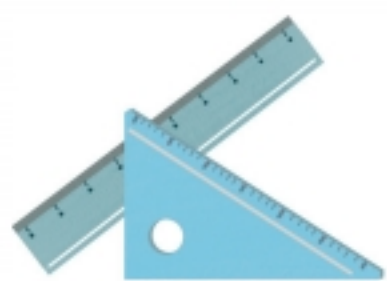

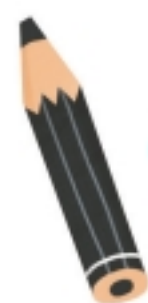
