How to Use This Book


Each unit in *Vivid Reading with Fiction Basic* includes eight parts plus additional review and consolidation activities in the workbook. These parts work together to lead students from visualizing the meaning of target vocabulary and thinking about the unit's topic to reading the passage and checking comprehension. After reading the passage and completing a comprehension check, students take on writing practice, review target vocabulary, practice basic sentence patterns related to the passages, and participate in listening comprehension and pronunciation activities. A summary of each section is presented here.

New Words

Lists key vocabulary along with illustrations that provide visual definitions for the words.

Picture Talk

Uses a key question to stimulate students' interest in the passage or illustration.



Find It!

Presents a quick interactive activity related to the current unit's key vocabulary.

Reading


Presents a great original story featuring either one large full-color illustration or six smaller full-color illustrations. An audio recording of each passage is provided on the CD.

Check It

Includes three comprehension sentences/questions related to the main passage.

Write It

Highlights key vocabulary and sentence patterns from the unit's main story in a new real-life context using photographs.



Learn It

Provides additional exposure to the target vocabulary of each unit as well as writing practice.


Say It




