#### **How to Use This Book**

Each unit in *Vivid Reading with Fiction Starter* has eight parts, plus additional review after every eight units and consolidation activities in the workbook. These parts work together to lead students from reviewing phonics, visualizing the meaning of target vocabulary, and thinking about the unit's topic to reading a passage and checking comprehension. After reading the passage and completing a comprehension check, students practice writing, review target vocabulary, study the basic sentence patterns used in the passage, and practice listening comprehension and pronunciation. The audio recordings of the passages and the listening activities are provided through QR codes. The function of each section is as follows.

#### **New Words**

Lists key vocabulary along with word tracing and illustrations that provide visual definitions for the words

Provides a chant to increase students' interest

#### **Sight Words**

Presents a quick interactive activity in which students look for two sight words in the passage




#### **Phonics Words**

Presents an interesting original story with color illustrations and a chant to improve listening and reading skills




Provides additional exposure to the phonics of the unit as well as listening practice

Provides additional practice in phonics, vocabulary, comprehension, and sentence production for each unit, which can be completed in class or as homework







