How to Use This Book


Each unit in *Vivid Reading with Fiction & Nonfiction Master* includes eight parts plus additional review and consolidation activities in the workbook. These parts work together to lead students from visualizing the meaning of target vocabulary and thinking about the unit's topic to reading the passage and checking comprehension. Range from original stories to informative passages presented with either full-color illustrations or photographs. An audio recording of each passage is provided on the CD.





Look and Think


