How to Use This Book


Each unit in *Vivid Reading with Fiction & Nonfiction Master* includes eight parts plus additional review and consolidation activities in the workbook. Ranges from original stories to informative passages presented with either full-color illustrations or photographs. An audio recording of each passage is provided online by a QR code.







Includes a short explanation of the unit along with a key question to stimulate students' interest in the passage


