

How to Use This Book

Each unit in *Vivid Reading with Fiction & Nonfiction Plus* includes eight parts plus additional review and consolidation activities in the workbook. These parts work together to lead students from visualizing the meaning of target vocabulary and thinking about the unit's topic to reading a passage and checking comprehension. After reading the passage and completing a comprehension check, students take on writing practice, review target vocabulary, practice sentence patterns related to the passages, and participate in listening comprehension and speaking activities. A summary of each section is presented here.

New Words

Lists key vocabulary along with illustrations that provide visual definitions for the words

Bonus Words

Presents words related to the unit's topic, giving students exposure to new words and interesting information





Warm Up

Includes a key question to stimulate students' interest in the passage or illustration

Find It!

Presents a quick and interactive activity related to the unit's key vocabulary


Reading

Provides additional exposure to the target vocabulary in new contexts, as well as writing practice


Say & Write It


