Blue, yellow, green, orange, and **pink** are **popular** colors.

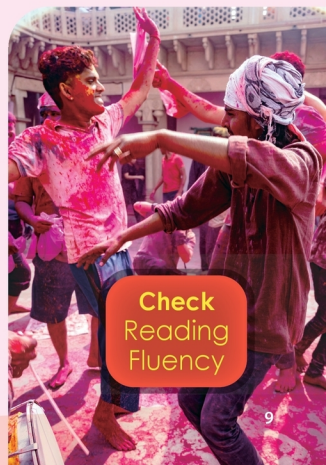
What else do people do during the festival?

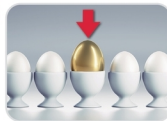
