



Don't Panic 103-04

Most pilots say that learning to fly is easy. The hard part is knowing what to do when something goes wrong. They practice over and over. It's important to do this. That way, they won't panic in a real emergency. It's the same for flight attendants. Here's an interview with a pilot who speaks about a recent emergency in the sky.

You had an emergency while flying recently. What happened? Pilot: Well, soon after we took off, there was smoke inside the plane. That is serious, obviously! First, I told air traffic control by radio about the smoke.

Then my co-pilot and
I checked our flight
manual. We looked
at the emergency checklist.



But we couldn't figure out the problem. So we told air traffic control that we had to turn around immediately.

Q2: Wow! That must have been scary. What did the flight attendants do?

Pilot: First, they calmly announced we were landing.

They made sure everyone stayed seated and helped some passengers who were panicking. Thankfully, we landed safely a few minutes later. (176 words)
