
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Long Vowel Q

Warm Up

Review the short vowels by brainstorming words that have short vowel sounds.



Listen and Repeat

- 1) Review short a. (This is short a. What sound does it make? Say /a/. What are some words with short a?)
- 2) Model the *long a* sound, $/\bar{a}/$, while showing students the *a* and *e* phonics cards. Have students repeat. (This is *long a*. It makes the sound $/\bar{a}/$. Say $/\bar{a}/$. This is *magic* e. It's a quiet letter. These letters are red in your books.)
- 3) Use the phonics cards to model how to blend the sounds of the letters in the target word. (Say /m/, $/\bar{a}/$, /n/, mane.) Remind students that the magic e is silent. Have students repeat.
- 4) Play the short DVD-ROM animation and encourage students to repeat the sounds and words.
- 5) Play Track 03. Have students point and glide their fingers along the words as they say them.

Listen and Match

Play Track 04 and have students draw lines to the vowel sounds of the words that they hear. Use the DVD-ROM to display the correct answers.

Trace and Say


Have students trace the target letters with their pencils. After they trace each *a* and *e*, have them say each word.

Listen and Repeat

- 1) Show students the DVD-ROM animation to introduce more long a words. Encourage students to repeat the sounds and words.
- 2) Practice the new words by using the teacher's flashcards. Ask and review the sound of each letter and model how to blend the sounds into a word. Have students repeat. (This is a mane. This is the word *mane*. What sounds do these letters make? Say /m/, /ā/, /n/, *mane*.)
- 3) Have students listen to Track 05. Remind them to point to the target word in their books and glide their fingers along it as they read.

Listen and Chant

Play Track 06 or the DVD-ROM chant animation. Play the chant again and have students chant along.
