

Unit Components



Introduction 1

The target letter combinations and sounds are introduced, and students practice blending each one into a word. Engaging illustrations make the phonics words easy for children to understand.

Practice 1

Students practice identifying the target sounds aurally.

Introduction 2

More words containing the target letter combinations and sounds are introduced. Students practice saying the words in a fun and simple chant.

Practice 2

Students practice recognizing the letter combinations as they hear them.

Use the included board games to provide a review of units 1–4 and 5–8 respectively. Students practice letter and word recognition through some friendly competition.




Reader
