Introduction 1

Students practice recognizing the phonics words as they hear them.



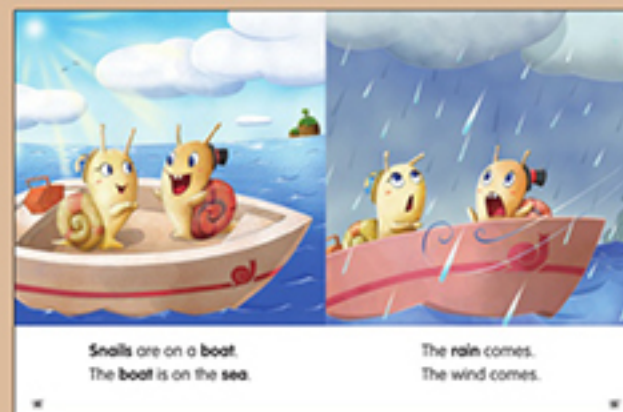
Board Games

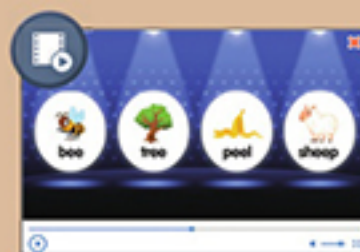
