Leah: I've climbed different walls. There are a lot of different types of walls and you can make them easier or more difficult. I've also gone with the club to the mountains in North Wales once a month for the last three years.

Leah: No, I've never done that. Nobody at my club ever climbs on their own; they always go with someone who can help if there is a problem.

SPS: 5

Leah: I'd like to, and more and more girls are winning them. However, it's very competitive and you have to train a lot. I also like climbing with others. When you climb with a team, you work together and there's a good atmosphere. People feel loyal to the team and quite caring towards the other members.

SPS: And here's the last question for you, Leah.

Leah: Well, there are a lot of good things, but the one I would mention is that it has made me self-confident. On the negative side, I would say that climbing leaves you feeling very, very tired! You have to concentrate very hard all the time and at the end of a climb your body and your brain are exhausted!


