Introduction

The books also offer support for children preparing for the Cambridge English Qualifications for young learners.

Vocabulary presentation

In the first part of each unit, key vocabulary is introduced in the context of a large, colourful scene, which will engage children and spark their curiosity. Children are encouraged to explore the scene through a series of short activities and accompanying audio.


Other books in the series
