Introduction

Team Together Vocabulary Boosters are designed to be a fun and engaging way of consolidating and extending vocabulary from the *Team Together* series. Each Vocabulary Booster includes 10 units, based around a different topic relevant to children and their lives. The books also offer support for children preparing for the Cambridge English Qualifications for young learners.

Vocabulary presentation

In the first part of each unit, key vocabulary is introduced in the context of a large, colourful scene, which will engage children and spark their curiosity. Children are encouraged to explore the scene through a series of short activities and accompanying audio.

Labels for key vocabulary.

Blank labels add an extra level of challenge for stronger students.

Audio and exercises present the language in context.

Vocabulary practice


In the second part of each unit, there are two pages of activities which provide further consolidation and practice of the vocabulary through a variety of fun activities.
